We will forward details of the pick up times and places closer to the time in consultation with the transport providers.

Alternatively, you are welcome to transport your son/daughter to school by car.

At the end of the day, pupils will go home in the same way in which they came to Llanidloes High School in the morning.

Please provide you son/daughter with snacks, packed lunch and refreshments.

### **Arrival**

Pupils will be met at the bus bay and brought to the school hall for a warm welcome before they start attending their lessons.

### **Clothing**

Please can pupils wear their Primary School uniform for the transition day.

### **Equipment**

Please can pupils bring stationary for the day.
