Dear parent/carer,

Every child in the school will be split into four teams. The teams are named after the Elan Valley dams. Each team has a colour –

Pen-Y-Garreg - Green Claerwen - White Graig Coch - Red Carreg Ddu – Blue

A slip will be sent home tomorrow with your child's team, siblings are all in the same team. Hopefully, this will prevent family rivalry! Ideally, your child will wear a t-shirt in the team colour. However, if you do not have a top in the correct colour a coloured sticker will be given on the day, so you do not need to rush out to buy a new top. Your child will need to wear a PE kit (trainers, shorts or tracksuit bottoms, t-shirt) and bring a filled drink bottle to school. Fruit and/or a snack will be provided for them on each rest station.

Each colour team is split into 5 sub-teams/groups of around 11 or 12 children. The groups will move around sixteen different segments of a large circle on the field during the morning. Every child will have the opportunity to take part in each event.
