PE Kit

Clothing for PE and Games (to be worn to school on PE days):

- Short sleeved t-shirt (jade, with or without logo)
- Shorts or joggers (black)
- Trainers

Please note that our PE uniform has become quite relaxed over the past few years. From September, we would like all children to wear the correct PE uniform. This will mean that they are equipped to represent their school at tournaments and that children do not feel pressured to wear expensive sports wear.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club (Squirrels) will open on Monday 4th September and will be led by Mrs Leanne Williams. Breakfast club opens at 8am and children may be dropped off any time until 8.45am. The cost of breakfast club is £3 which includes a health breakfast / £5 for pre-school children.

Parents who intend to use the club will need to complete some forms with information about their child. These will be shared with you closer to the time. Please allow a little time on the first day for ensuring all paperwork is in place before your child begins.

After-School Club

After School Club (Squirrels) will open on Monday 4th September and will be led by Miss Clare Lloyd. After school club will be open until 5.30pm. The cost of after school club is £6 which includes a healthy snack / £10 for pre-school children.

School Lunch

All pupils in Beech, Cherry and Hazel class (R- Y3) will be eligible for a free school lunch from Monday 4th September. The roll out of free lunches for Y4 – Y6 will continue over the course of the year.

Parents preparing a packed lunch for their child are reminded that this should not include any sweets or chocolate and water bottles should contain water only.

Attendance

It is very important that you call school by 9.15am if your child is going to be absent due to illness or an appointment. If we haven't heard from you, we will call you, as we must account for the whereabouts of every pupil every day.

If you are requesting authorisation for a term time holiday, this must be done 28 days in advance. The forms can be found on our website [here](#) and there are paper copies in reception.

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School Car Park

Our school car park is a very busy place at the beginning and end of the day. Please teach your child road safety by always crossing at the zebra crossing. The drop off zone in front of the school should only be used for older children who are confident to 'kiss and ride'. Parents/carers of younger children should park their car in a bay and walk their child to the gate.
