Staff voice

We have been taking some feedback from our staff about our behaviour policy. Pupil behaviour during lesson times has been highlighted as outstanding by many external agencies. Pupils behave very well during lesson times and any disruption to learning is dealt with quickly and effectively. Unfortunately, this isn't always the case during playtimes. Some Teaching Assistants feel that some children do not show the same level of respect towards them. Teachers will be speaking to their classes about the need to show <u>all</u> adults and children respect. We would be very grateful if you could follow this up with your children at home so that they are hearing consistent messages. Any incidents of a pupil showing disrespectful behaviour to an adult in school will lead to a repair conversation and loss of end of term reward.

We appreciate your support in ensuring playtimes are enjoyable for all staff and pupils alike.
