Cognition and Learning Support Service (CLASS) - New Traded Offer, 2023-24

The Cognition and Learning Support Service (CLASS) will be changing the way it delivers its services from September 2023. To ensure that CLASS remains as a viable service within the current economic climate, the advisory teachers for cognition and learning will become fully traded so will no longer be providing free services to schools next academic year.

The new CLASS traded offers includes a 'daily rate' (£462) within which the school can plan with the advisory teacher a range of bespoke activities such as consultations, assessments, advice and modelling of interventions. There is also a wide range of training courses on offer (both centralised and whole school), plus a package to support schools to achieve and maintain the 'Swindon Dyslexia Friendly Schools Quality Mark'.

"YOU SAID, WE DID" - TIMING OF REQUESTS FOR **EDUCATION HEALTH AND CARE NEEDS ASSESSMENTS**

The SEND Service is continuously looking at ways to improve collaborative working with schools, parents and other partners. As you will be aware making a request for an EHC needs assessment is a legal right and you are free to do so at any time. However, following feedback that consultations (week 16-17 of the 20 week process) were falling in periods of schools closure, such as the summer holidays and other 2 week holidays we have created a calendar which indicates 'good' (colour coded in green) submission weeks that will avoid this happening for you.
