<u>A Victorian Lady</u>

A white apron and either a black long sleeved dress or a long black skirt and long sleeved black top.

<u>A Victorian Man</u>

A white shirt with a blazer and trousers. For shoes, draw a buckle on card and fasten onto plain black school shoes.

<u>Chimney Cleaner</u>

Ruggedly cut the bottoms off some brown or grey trousers, which they can wear with plimsolls or school shoes. Add a scruffy white shirt; you could dye one in tea to make it look more authentic! (To do this add a tea bag to a bucket of warm water and soak the shirt in it.) Put some dirt or brown/black face paint on their face and hands to make it look like they've been up a chimney

<u>Market Girl</u>

A long, dark-coloured dress or skirt with a long sleeved blouse. Add a shawl around the shoulders and a head scarf around the head.
