

## Penodi Pennaeth ar gyfer ysgol newydd Aberhonddu

Mae wedi cael ei gyhoeddi bod ysgol gynradd newydd a fydd yn agor yn ne Powys y flwyddyn nesaf wedi cyrraedd carreg filltir arwyddocaol gyda phenodiad y pennnaeth.

Penodwyd Sarah Court yn Bennaeth yr ysgol gynradd newydd yn Aberhonddu yn dilyn proses recriwtio helaeth a gafodd ei oruchwyllo gan Gorff Llywodraethu Dros Dro yr ysgol.

Bydd yr ysgol newydd yn agor ym mis Medi 2024 yn dilyn uno Ysgol Fabanod Mount Street, Ysgol Iau Mount Street ac Ysgol Gynradd Gymunedol Cradoc fel rhan o gynlluniau Trawsnewid Addysg gan Gyngor Sir Powys.

Dechreuodd Mrs Court ei gyrfa addysgu 30 mlynedd yn ôl. Yn ystod ei hamser, datblygodd ei sgiliau addysgu ac arwain trwy amrywiaeth o rolau addysgu, uwch arwain a chynggori yn y DU a ledled y byd. Treuliodd Mrs Court sawl blwyddyn yn gweithio i'r Gwasanaeth Addysg Plant y Lluoedd Arfog Prydeinig yn yr Almaen. Mae Mrs Court yn byw ger Aberhonddu.

## Headteacher appointed for new Brecon school

A new primary school that will open in south Powys next year has reached a significant milestone with the appointment of a headteacher, it has been announced.

Sarah Court has been appointed as Headteacher for the new primary school in Brecon following an extensive recruitment process overseen by the school's Temporary Governing Body.

The new school will open in September 2024 following the merger of Mount Street Infants School, Mount Street Junior School and Cradoc C.P. school as part of Transforming Education plans by Powys County Council.

Mrs Court, who lives near Brecon, started her teaching career 30 years ago. During her time, she developed her teaching and leadership skills through a variety of teaching, senior leadership and advisory roles in the UK and around the world. Mrs Court spent several years working for Service Children's Education for the British Armed Forces in Germany.

Mrs Court currently leads the council's Vulnerable Groups Team, supporting schools, pupils and families from
