We'll have lots of fun finding out about each other, make new friends and learn about what makes us special.

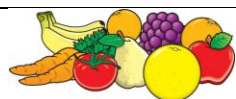

Snack time

All children will be given the choice of milk or water at snack time. Please can you provide a piece of fruit [or vegetables if you prefer] for your child each day. If you feel your child is not able to eat a whole piece of fruit, please send chopped up fruit in a pot with their name on. Please remember to cut grapes in half.



Water Bottles

It is important that the children have access to **water** at all times throughout the day. Please bring a **water** bottle to school each day and remember to write your child's name on the bottle too.



Playtimes

All children will need to keep a pair of **wellies** in school as they will be wearing wellies at playtime and lunchtime. As the weather is very changeable at this time of year, please can you ensure that your child also has a **coat** in school every day.



Birthdays

Reading

Your child will bring home new reading books regularly. Please try to read with your child as often as you can and write a comment in their reading record to let us know that you have read at home. All children will have sounds or words to practice too.



Book Bags

Bookbags are available from the School Office at a cost of £6.

Please bring book bags to school every day. There will be a yellow Reading Record book for you to sign letting us know when your child has read at home. The bookbags are showerproof but please do not carry snacks or water bottles in them as any spillage means soggy books.



PE

PE will be on **Wednesday** afternoon. Please can your child come to school wearing their PE kit

[shorts/ joggers/ leggings, t-shirt, jumper, and trainers]



Swimming

Only **Year1** children will be swimming this term. Swimming will be on a **Thursday** starting on September 7th.

Reception children will begin swimming lessons later in the year. More information will follow closer to the time.



Forest School

Forest School sessions this term will be on a **Friday**. We provide waterproof trousers but all children will need a waterproof coat. Waterproof trousers are much easier to put on if your child is wearing trousers or leggings. Skirts and dresses tend to roll up inside the waistband and are uncomfortable

Clothing & Shoes

We encourage the children to be as independent as possible. Please can your child wear shoes they can take off and put back on, by themselves, eg. Velcro fastenings or side zips are the best choice. Buckles are a bit fiddly and laces are really difficult until the children learn how to tie knots. Please can you write your child's name on their jumpers so they can be reunited at the end of the day. Diolch.
