Following the decision by Powys County Council to merge Mount Street Infants School, Mount Street Junior School and Cradoc C.P. School, the Council is now moving forward with the plans to establish a new primary school. The aim of this newsletter is to keep you updated on any new developments. Further editions will be issued regularly up until the new school opens.

Update on School Uniform and the Logo Competition

At the last Full Temporary Governing Body (TGB) meeting it was agreed that the uniform colour for Ysgol Golwg Pen y Fan will be **classic red** jumpers/cardigans, with or without a logo/red or white tops with black/grey trousers/ skirts. This was decided to make sure there is minimum disruption and minimum financial cost to parents, and we will provide a full uniform policy update and guidance shortly

At the next TGB meeting on 6 June 2024 the winning logo will receive a final TGB approval, then the logo will be unveiled in the schools and information will be sent to parents along with a copy of the uniform policy information.

During the three schools time of transition to one school we will encourage families to continue to use existing uniform and logos. There will be no need to purchase new uniform with logos unless your child has grown out of it or are starting new at the school.

We will provide opportunities for old uniform to be recycled across all campuses. A school jumper will be available for parents to purchase from a local uniform supplier, this jumper will have the new school logo embroidered on the jumper.

For parents / carers wishing to buy classic red jumpers from local supermarkets etc. The logo will be available as an embroidered patch to be purchased to sew on to jumpers if you wish.

Further information including the price of jumpers, the price of embroidered patches and how to order will be available in Newsletter Issue 9 which is due for publication around mid-June.

The 2024 / 25 Year 6 Leavers are currently being consulted on the details of their leaver hoodies. More information on these special hoodies for Year 6 only, will be available in the Newsletter Issue 9.
