PTA Family Fun day this Saturday 2-7pm



Processes for Reporting and Managing Covid

This academic year our processes around covid cases is different as Welsh Government guidance has changed. We no longer have to close bubbles in the event of a confirmed Covid case. Instead, we send a 'Warn and Inform' letter to the affected year groups, which is a communication to make parents aware there is a covid case. Both Year Two and Year Six have received this letter this week. **We will send this letter whenever we receive a notification of a confirmed case so it is possible you may receive the letter more than once.**

To be able to send these letters, we are reliant on Parents informing us of positive results of children in school. We have to keep a log of all children who have to go for a PCR test, so please still keep to the same procedure of contacting us if your child is going for a PCR test and then let us know the result of that test. We know that Parents at Evenlode are brilliant at keeping us in the loop of any cases so thankyou. Range of symptoms

People living in Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan can now have a free coronavirus test if they have any of a wider range of symptoms.

As well as the three most common symptoms of Covid-19 - **a fever, a new continuous cough or a loss/change of taste and smell** - people are now able to get a test if they have any of a new list of other symptoms too.

These are fatigue, myalgia (muscle ache or pain), a sore throat, a headache, sneezing, a runny nose, a loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhoea.

The Cardiff and Vale Test, Trace, Protect Service is now advising that you should book a test if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms: fatigue, myalgia (muscle ache or pain), a sore throat, a headache, sneezing, a runny nose, a loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhoea.
