I would like to thank all of you, as part of our Durand Primary School family, for your continued support, patience and understanding during what has continued to be unprecedented times. As staff we really appreciate the community spirit around our school!



#### **September 2021**

As you will have read in the letter from Will McLean, Chief Officer, Children and Young People there will be very little change to how Primary schools operate in September. The latest revised guidance that we have received still asks us in schools to operate with tighter restrictions than those proposed for wider society.

This year we have operated a very successful free flow entry and exit system adjusting the operation of the school day to ensure that we have maintained the correct number of teaching and learning hours. From September we are going to continue with the one-way system free flow entry and exit process from each individual classroom's external door but we will be adjusting the times as follows:

**Morning arrival – gates to be opened at 8.50am and pupils will go straight to their classes by 9am at the latest**

**Afternoon departing – gates will be opened at 3.05pm to enable parents to get to their child's class for a 3.10pm finish**

The following will still apply:

- Items brought from home kept to a minimum. No big rucksacks please.
- PE kits to be worn to school on the day/days required. Staff will let pupils and parents know which days in September
- Regular hand washing and the use of hand sanitiser will continue.
- The wearing of face coverings for drop off and pick up as the guidance still specifies that 'Visitors to the school setting should use a face covering, including parents/carers when dropping off and picking up learners.'
- Leave the school site straight away and not congregate either on site or just outside.
- During drop off, as we still have staff outside to assist, you may wish to consider allowing older pupils (Key Stage 2) to come onto site independently in order to walk around to class.
- Late arrivals to report to the buzzer gate.

Should we receive further updates during the summer break then I will send out details of any changes via Schoop.
